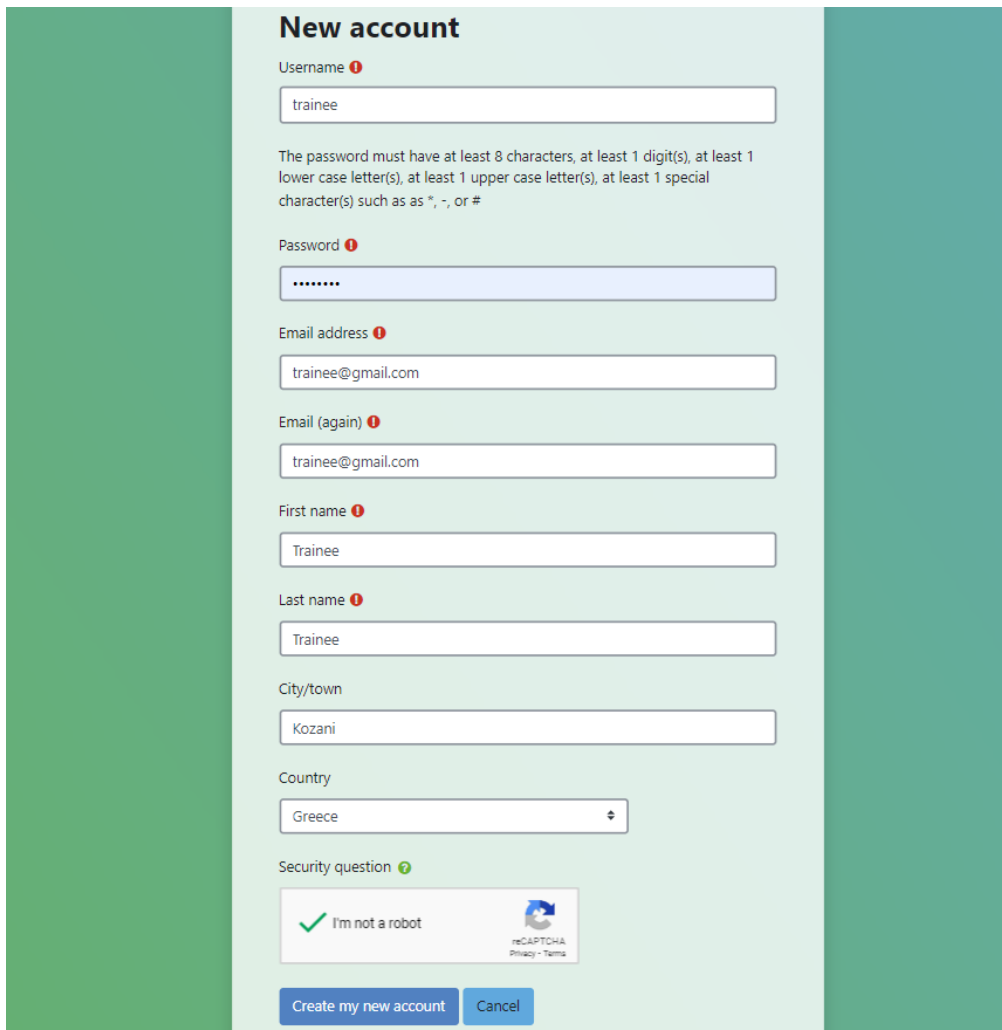

## 1.1. Account creation

To create a trainee account:

- Navigate to the “Log in” menu and click “Create new account”. Follow the instructions and agree to the Privacy Policy. Fill in your details according to the form and click “Create my new account”.

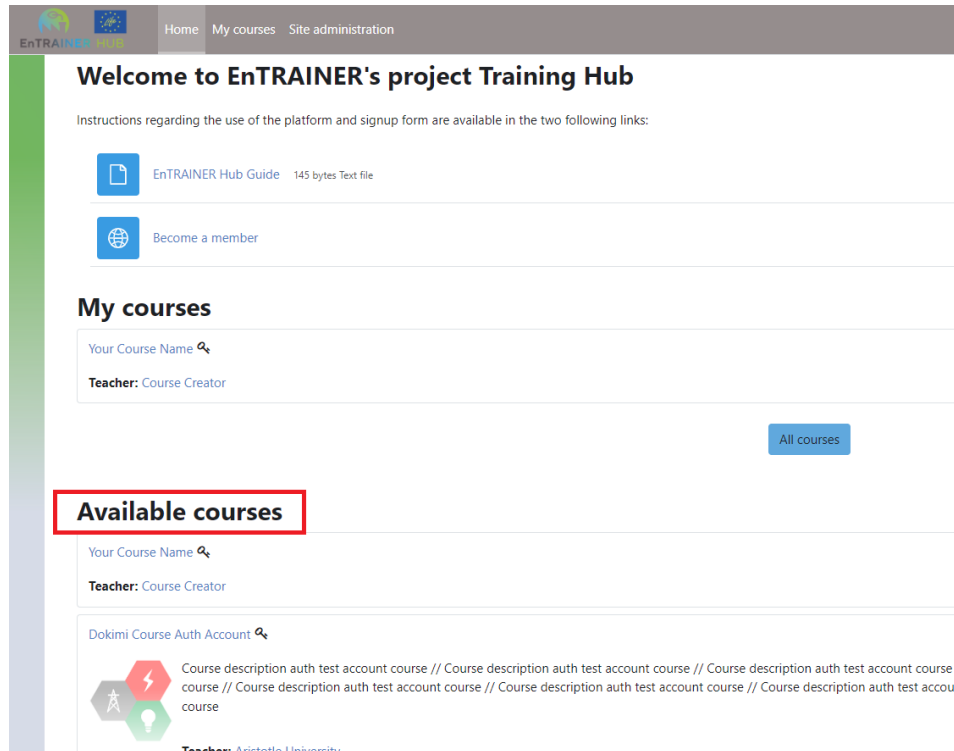

## 1.2. Course enrolment

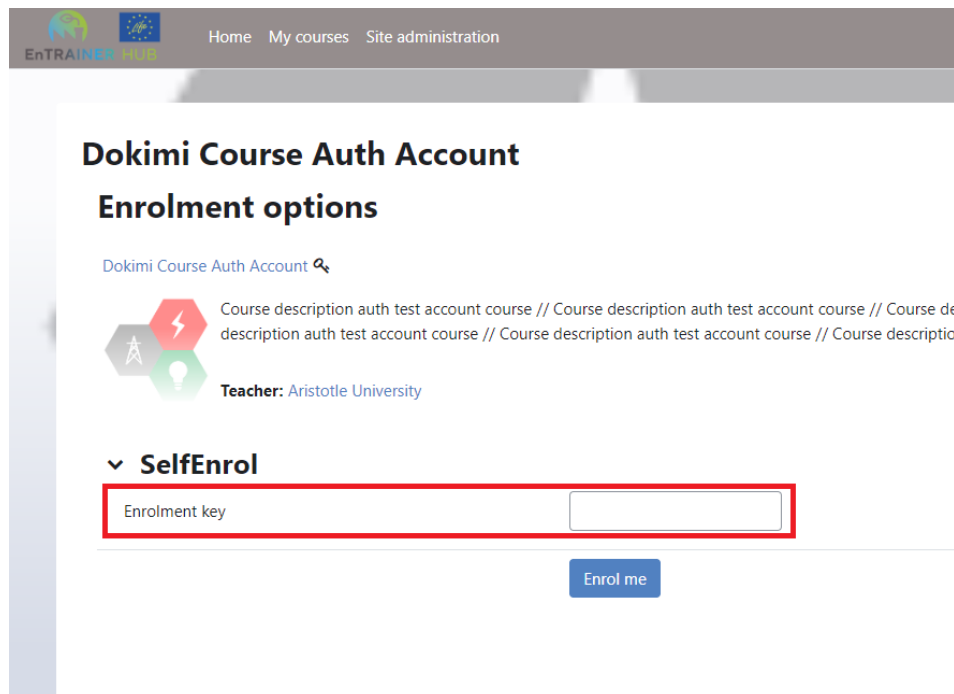
- Select a course to enrol from the “Available courses” at the homepage. Additional instructions may be given by the trainer who may have invited you to join the platform.

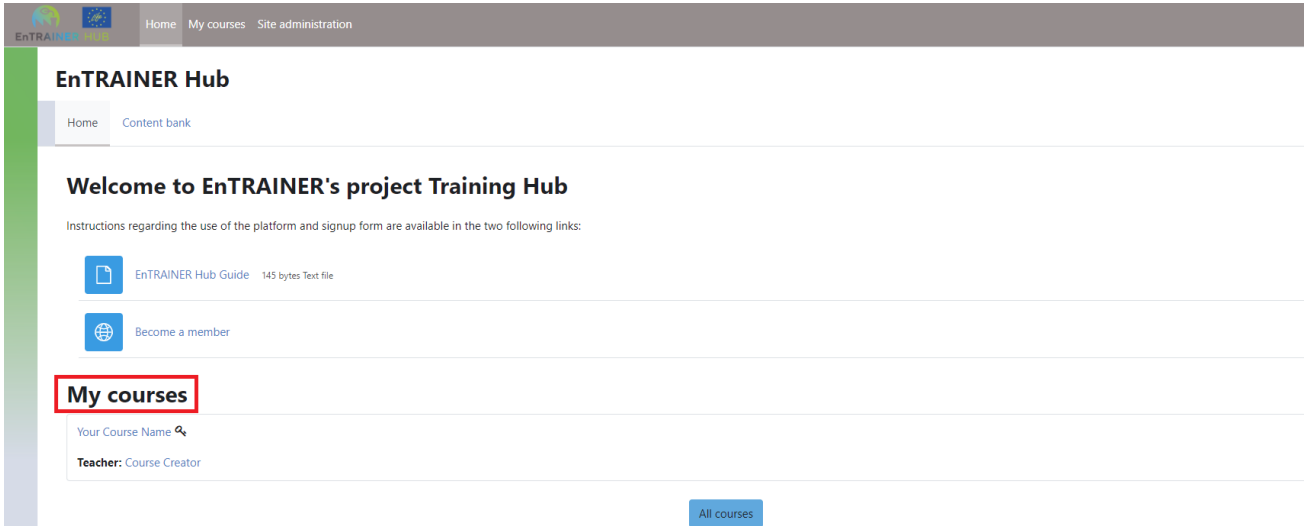

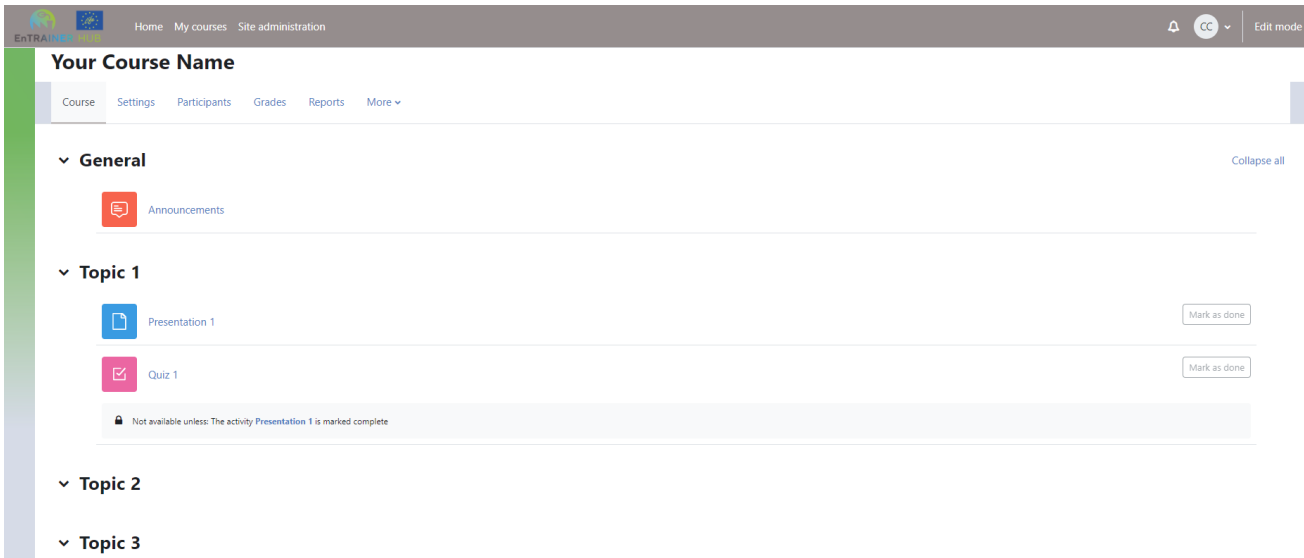
- After enrolling, the course will become available at “My courses” at the homepage.





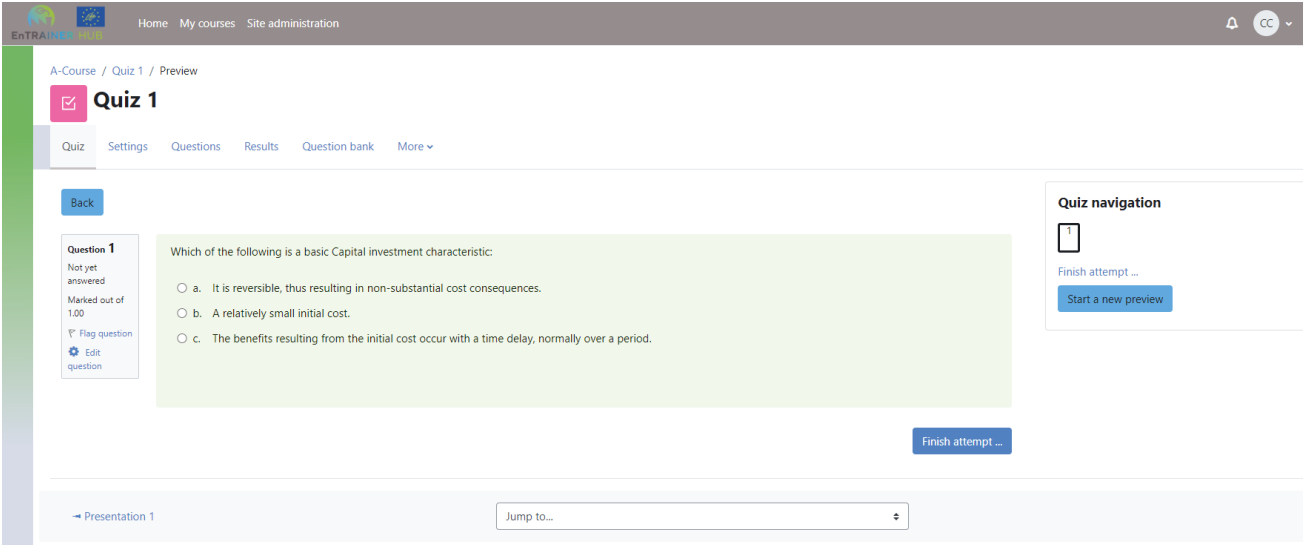
### 1.3. Course content

After enrolling, the topics and activities set by the trainer become available, and the navigation block reveals additional information regarding the course, such as Badges, Competencies and Grades. Training material and activities are posted by the trainer, and the final course content may vary. Typically, courses will contain an introduction section, training material and examination/evaluation activities as depicted below:



- By clicking any of the available material in the course, a new page will appear which may include files, information, a forum, or self-evaluation material.
